Moving services are deemed ESSENTIAL in the Government of Ontario List of Essential Workers. See Items #17 and #67 on the list: transportation services, warehousing and storage, & moving services.

The health and safety of our customers and our entire staff team is our top priority. We are closely monitoring the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and are taking the following steps to ensure healthy work environments and business continuity.

We have updated our health and safety procedures to include:

- Frequent and proper hand-washing and use of available hand sanitizers
- Use of disinfecting wipes for cellphones, steering wheels, truck cab interiors, door handles and all suspect points of hand contact
- Refrain from handshakes, high-fives and unnecessary human contact
- Where practical, practice social distancing
- Employees are instructed to self isolate if they have cold or flu-like symptoms
- Cough or sneeze into your clothing elbow or sleeve. Avoid touching your face
- Restricting all non essential business travel
- Wear the clean work gloves provided
- Confirming with customers that they are not showing any flu-like symptoms before our staff arrive to provide moving services

What can we all do?

- Practice proper and frequent handwashing: Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds (or using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available)
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick or have traveled outside of the country in the past 14 days
- Practice good cough and sneeze etiquette
- Practice Social Distancing
- Limit personal contact; avoid handshakes, hugs and large crowd
- Disinfect your home; clean all door handles, light switches, remotes, cellphones and all commonly used surfaces

- Stay home if you are feeling sick or flu like symptoms
- Restrict all non-essential travel
